

CANUCKS FOR KIDS FUND SIGNED JERSEY 2024 CONTEST
(the “Contest”)

RULES AND REGULATIONS

THIS CONTEST IS BROUGHT TO YOU BY VANCOUVER CANUCKS LIMITED PARTNERSHIP (“VCLP”) IN COOPERATION WITH CANUCKS FOR KIDS FUND (“CFKF”). NO PURCHASE IS NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN. A PURCHASE DOES NOT INCREASE THE CHANCES OF WINNING. CONTEST IS VOID IN WHOLE OR PART WHERE PROHIBITED BY LAW. SEE ELIGIBILITY SECTION BELOW FOR FURTHER DETAILS. TO PARTICIPATE IN THE CONTEST YOU MUST READ AND AGREE TO THESE RULES AND REGULATIONS. PARTICIPATION IN THE CONTEST CONSTITUTES FULL AND UNCONDITIONAL AGREEMENT AND ACCEPTANCE OF THESE RULES AND REGULATIONS, AS THE SAME MAY BE AMENDED BY VCLP FROM TIME TO TIME IN ITS SOLE DISCRETION UPON NOTICE (POSTING AMENDED RULES AND REGULATIONS SHALL BE DEEMED TO BE SUFFICIENT NOTICE). ALL DOLLAR AMOUNTS ARE IN CANADIAN DOLLARS (\$CDN) UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED.

(1) CONTEST PERIOD:

The Contest will begin at 12:00 PM (Pacific Time) on April 17, 2024 and ends at 9:00 PM (Pacific Time) at the first playoff home game (date TBA).

(2) ELIGIBILITY:

In order to be eligible to win a prize, you must be a resident of the Province of British Columbia, at least 19 years of age, and must not be (and no member of your immediate family shall be) an employee of VCLP or any of its affiliates which collectively with VCLP operate as Canucks Sports & Entertainment (hereinafter “CSE”) or CFKF or any affiliate of the foregoing. For the purposes of these Rules and Regulations, "immediate family" means husband, wife, spouse, mother, father, brother, sister, son and/or daughter, whether by blood, marriage or adoption and whether or not they reside in the same household.

VCLP shall have the right at any time to require proof of identity and/or eligibility to participate in the Contest. Failure to provide such proof may result in disqualification. All personal and other information requested by and supplied to VCLP for the purpose of the Contest must be truthful, complete, accurate and in no way misleading. VCLP reserves the right to disqualify any entry or entrant in its sole discretion, should any entry or entrant at any stage contain and/or supply untruthful, incomplete, inaccurate, or misleading personal details and/or information.

(3) HOW TO ENTER:

There are two methods to enter the Contest:

1. Vancouver Canucks 50/50 Method:

- i. During the Contest Period, make an online purchase of a CFKF Vancouver Canucks 50/50 ticket using a web browser at www.canucks.com/5050 or using the Canucks app, and opt-in to entering the Contest during the purchase process. You will receive one (1) entry into the prize draw. There is no limit to the number of entries per person by this entry method.
2. Letter Method (no purchase necessary):
 - i. To enter the Contest without making a 50/50 purchase, please mail a handwritten letter requesting a free entry along with your legal name, date of birth, email, mailing address and cell phone number to: ATTN: Canucks for Kids Fund Signed Jersey Contest, 89 W. Georgia Street, Vancouver, BC V6B 0N8. If your letter is received by VCLP prior to the end of the Contest Period, you will receive one (1) entry into the prize draw. There is a limit of one entry per person to the Contest by this entry method.

Potential winners may be required to provide VCLP with proof that the potential winner is the authorized account holder of the email address associated with the winning entry.

(4) PRIZE:

There will be one (1) prize to be won, consisting of one (1) autographed Vancouver Canucks J.T. Miller Home Jersey, having an approximate retail value of \$400. All prizes will be awarded and are provided "AS IS" without warranty of any kind, express or implied.

(5) WINNER SELECTION:

The prize winner(s) will be randomly selected on or around the end of the Contest Period from all qualified entries. Any potential winner will be contacted via phone or email within the first week following their random selection. Odds of winning a prize depend on the number of entrants who participate in the Contest.

A selected entrant will be required to correctly answer, unaided, a time-limited mathematical skill-testing question to be administered by VCLP and to confirm his/her eligibility.

A selected entrant must also agree to sign and return VCLP's standard Declaration and Release Form before being eligible to receive a prize.

If any selected entrant does not meet all of the Contest conditions or does not reply within five (5) days of the initial documented contact attempt by VCLP, that entrant will be disqualified and VCLP shall be entitled to randomly select a new entrant from amongst the remaining eligible entries in accordance with these Rules and Regulations.

Once a potential winner is determined, the winning entrant will be directed as to how to claim their prize, which will be delivered within a reasonable time.

(6) GENERAL RULES:

This Contest is void where prohibited by law and is subject to all applicable federal, provincial and municipal laws and regulations. All incidental costs and expenses not specifically referred to herein, including (without limitation) taxes, shall be the sole responsibility of the prize winner. All trademarks are the property of the respective owners.

To the maximum extent permitted by applicable law, by entering the Contest, you agree to release and hold harmless CSE, VCLP, CFKF, the National Hockey League and its Member Teams, NHL Enterprises Canada L.P., and the respective governors, subsidiaries, affiliates, agents, directors, officers, employees and representatives of each of the foregoing (collectively, the “Released Parties”) from and against any and all liability, damages, claims, costs and expenses, including reasonable attorneys’ fees, or causes of action (however named or described) with respect to or arising out of: (i) your participation in the Contest, (ii) the receipt or use of the prize(s) awarded therein, or (iii) the administration of the Contest and the distribution of the prize(s) awarded therein.

Subject to the foregoing, any controversy or dispute arising out of the conduct of this Contest shall be resolved exclusively in the courts of the Province of British Columbia applying the laws of the Province of British Columbia (and federal laws of Canada applicable therein), to which exclusive jurisdiction and law the entrants agree to submit as evidenced by their participation in the Contest.

- Authorize and grant any of the Released Parties the right to use, reproduce and distribute your name, address (city/town only), any content submitted in connection with your submission, and, if photographs are taken, your images and likenesses in connection with

the Contest or for general promotional purposes, without further compensation or notification, to the extent permitted by law.

(8) LIMITATIONS OF LIABILITY:

To the maximum extent permitted by applicable law, the Released Parties are not responsible, whether as a result of human error or otherwise, for any failure to contact any potential winners, nor for any incorrect or inaccurate information, whether caused by website users or by any of the equipment or programming associated with or utilized in the Contest or by any technical or human error which may occur in the processing of submissions in the Contest. The Released Parties assume no responsibility for any error, omission, tampering, interruption, deletion, defect, delay in operation or transmission, communications line failure, theft or destruction, unauthorized access to or alteration of entries, or any injury, damages, claims, costs, and expenses arising in connection with any prize or from participation in the Contest.
